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HAMPTON ROADS CLOSURES ON WATER CROSSINGS, INTERSTATES AND OTHER NOTABLE DETOURS

For the week of Feb. 2-8

NOTE: This list covers full closures of interstates, ramps, bridges and primary roads, and lane closures at the bridge-tunnels and the Berkley, Coleman, High Rise and James River bridges.

Scheduled closures are subject to change based on weather conditions.

Bridges & Tunnels:

Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel, I-64:

- Mobile, shoulder closures in both directions on Feb. 3-7 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Alternating, single-lane closures westbound on Feb. 3-6 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Single-lane closure eastbound on Feb. 6 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel, I-664:

- Single-lane closure southbound on Feb. 3-5 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Alternating, mobile, single-lane closures northbound on Feb. 6 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

James River Bridge, Route 17

- Alternating, mobile, single-lane closures in both directions on Feb. 4-5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

George P. Coleman Bridge, Route 17

- Alternating, mobile, single-lane closures in both directions on Feb. 3-4 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



I-64 Widening Project, Newport News / York County / James City County:

- Single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Route 199 Lightfoot exit (exit 234) to Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) Jan. 2-6, starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- A consecutive, long-term lane closure under traffic signal control on Colonial Parkway at the I-64 overpass continues.
- A consecutive, long-term full ramp closure on Route 143 Merrimac Trail north to I-64 west continues. Traffic will follow detour signage in place directing motorists to the Route 143 south on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.

I-64 Express Lanes

- Full closure of I-64 Express lanes in both directions on Feb. 3 from 9 to 11 a.m.

I-64 Southside Widening, High Rise Bridge Expansion:

- Alternating, single-lane closures on I-64 in both directions between South Military Highway (exit 281) and Greenbrier Parkway (exit 289):
 - Feb. 3-6, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Feb. 7, from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.
 - Feb. 8, from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
 - Feb. 9, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.



I-64/I-264 Interchange Improvements Project, Norfolk/Virginia Beach:

- Alternating, double-lane closures on I-64 west from Twin Bridges to I-264 on Feb. 3-7. starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Full closure of the on-ramp from southbound Newtown Road to I-264 east on Feb. 5-7 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- Single-lane closure on I-264 east from Military Highway (exit 13) to Newtown Road (exit 15) on Feb. 5-8 starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Alternating, single-lane closures on the I-64 west exit ramp (exit 284) to mainline I-264 east on Feb. 6-7 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Full closure of the I-264 east collector-distributor road (outside set) from I-64 to Newtown Road (exit 15) on Feb. 5-6 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. The exit ramp from the I-264 east collector-distributor road to Newtown Road (exit 15), will remain open during this time.

Elizabeth River Tunnels (Downtown/Midtown tunnels):
